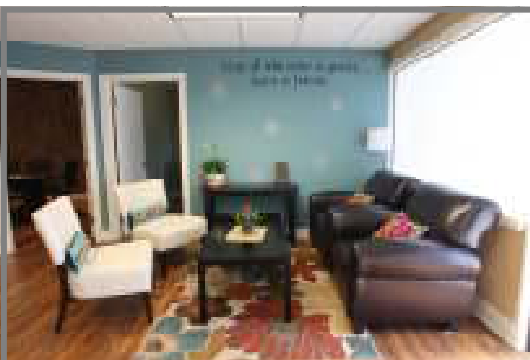
## Corporate Restructuring Goes Smoothly

WEST DES MOINES, IA – Informed Choices Medical Clinic of West Des Moines is proud to announce that as of January 1 our name has changed to InnerVisions Healthcare. At the same time our organization is unveiling a new corporate identity and website, [www.innervisionshealthcare.org](http://www.innervisionshealthcare.org).

The clinic continues to offer free medical services provided by a team of medical doctors and nurses - most of whom volunteer their time and professional skills in serving patients who are facing unplanned pregnancies and/or sexually transmitted diseases (STD).

And now, partnering with Mercy Clinical Laboratories, all lab testing is done at Mercy Hospital in Des Moines.

Stephen Cashman, Chairman of the Board of InnerVisions HealthCare said, "With the help and support of Informed Choice of Iowa in Iowa City, this clinic was built to serve the growing needs of women and men in the metro and surrounding areas who want to have all the information available as they make decisions pertaining to their health and their future. The community has been overwhelmingly supportive and the new Board of Directors and everyone involved is excited about having the opportunity

to provide these free services to those in need."

Since June 2011 we've served individuals by providing free STD tests, pregnancy tests and ultrasound services using professionally trained medical personnel with state of the art equipment. According to Cashman, "The organization's focus is to meet the fundamental needs of our clients (i.e.: ongoing medical, financial and community resources), by caring for them with compassion and empathy and to empower them to make the most informed decisions possible."

InnerVisions HealthCare operates as a subsidiary of The Human Choice of Iowa, under a DBA.

### Missionary Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe to Visit Clinic

The Image coming to Des Moines is one of two life-sized exact copies of the image of Our Lady left on the outer garment worn by Mexican Juan Diego which has miraculously remained intact for over 480 years, despite being bombed and attacked with acid.
