# Influencing the Culture of Life throughout Iowa



As our reputation has grown and we have built an excellent staff who work tirelessly as servants in this ministry, it has allowed me the opportunity to respond to needs of other servant leaders in the field and share my experiences and 'wisdom' to help the culture of life grow in lowa. This has led me to serve in a couple of key roles.

First, as a member of the lowa Knights of Columbus Respect Life Committee. The Knights have implemented their ultrasound initiative by placing machines in pregnancy resource centers. They hope to see a 50% decrease in abortions by 2020. As a

consultant on the committee my task is to meet with centers who seek to expand into a 'clinic' – and therefore work with their leadership in preparing their organization to handle the responsibilities and operations of running a medical clinic.
