



Plans For Inner Visions South

With access to important support services along a bus route, InnerVisions South will be within the St. Vincent de Paul building complex. Both InnerVisions West and InnerVisions South will operate under a single integrated technology platform, with one management team, reducing the average cost of service per patient and improve operating efficiency.




With over 5400 sq. ft, the new InnerVisions South clinic will provide more than three times the space currently available at InnerVisions West. The building interior will be remodeled to create a professional, welcoming atmosphere designed to fit our specific needs.

InnerVisions South will have ultrasound, counseling, and exam rooms, in addition to classroom and conference space. These rooms will accommodate InnerVisions' expanded outreach and support programs, such as education, coaching and mentoring for mothers, fathers and siblings.

As we open InnerVisions South, we will expand our marketing efforts that inform the public about our professional services and personalized care. This will increase awareness with both patients and referral sources about who we are and what we do.
